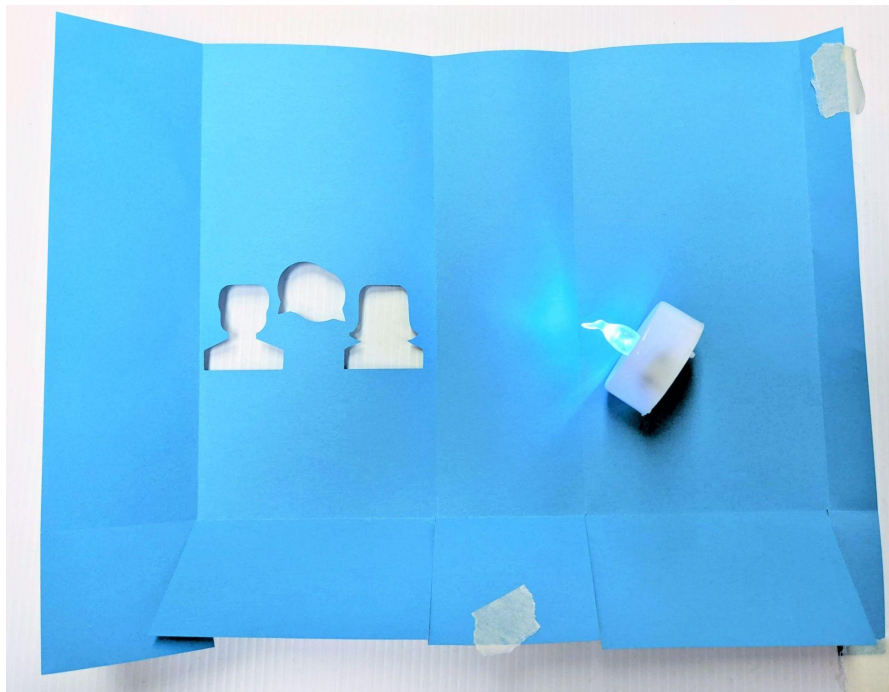
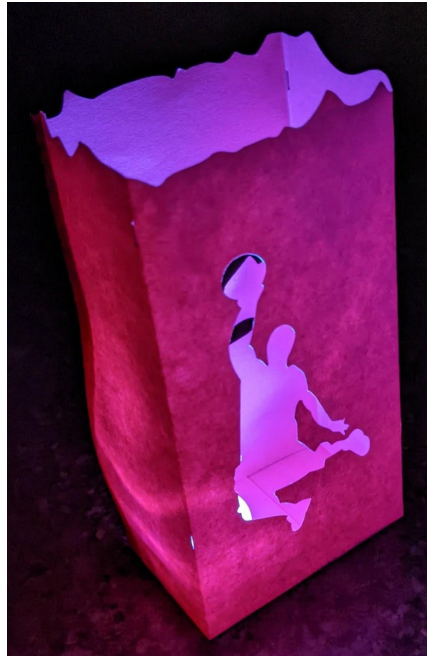
Specialized tools and materials used:	Experience level required:
Craft/Vinyl cutter (Cricut, Silhouette, etc) Vector design software (gravit, Vectr, Inkscape...) colorful paper battery-powered tealights tape or glue	Beginner

**Grade Level and Subject** (of this example): All Ages/Grades

**Topic/Content Standards** (for this example): Maker Skill/Starter Project



Use a Cricut or similar craft cutter to make small paper bags with cut-out designs, or try using vinyl stickers. The bag can easily be folded and glued or taped together. Use a scoring tool with the Cricut to make folding the bag even easier. Once assembled, illuminate with a battery-powered tealight (or any LED and a coin cell battery.)
